- Sharon Penney noted that in 2002 North Country Council Regional Planning Commission did an access management plan regarding curb cuts and traffic circulation on TMH. At the time, the NH DOT was really pushing for access roads and congestion management on state highways. The study was updated in 2014 by North Country Council with new traffic count studies and curb cut information which reflected development over the ten year time period between studies. She noted she has a cd on this information that is accessible for anyone to use.
