7. Permit is issued in the name of the excavating contractor and it is his/her obligation to meet all of the conditions of this permit.

8. Sawcut – straight lines and vertical faces 2' beyond the disturbed area.

9. Areas of excavation should be minimized and in conformance with OSHA regulations.

10. Excavation soils containing organic material, pavement, broken ledge and stones larger than 12" shall not be used as backfill.

11. Excavation soils suitable for backfill shall be replaced in order of removal and compacted in 12" lifts to 95% maximum dry density.

12. Under paved areas shall be placed a minimum of 12" bank run gravel (NHDOT item 304.2) and 6" crushed bank run gravel (NHDOT item 304.3).

13. Restoration of concrete roadways and sidewalks shall be at the direction of the Highway Manager.

14. Depth of asphalt/loam restoration shall be equal to the existing conditions OR 3" asphalt / 4" loam; whichever is greater.

15. Suitable traffic control including ingress and egress to properties abutting the work area, shall be maintained at all times.

16. Dust control shall be provided to prevent nuisance to abutters and the surrounding areas.

17. During the weekends and holidays, and on workdays during the hours the job is inactive, a stand-by crew shall be available in case they are needed for the protection and maintenance of traffic.

Contractor shall furnish one or more telephone number, which will reach the stand-by crew, to the following people. Signatures required below:

18. In those instances where the cut or trench travels a significant distance along the traveled way, the contractor may be required to shim/overlay the road surface.

19. A bond or certified check in the minimum amount of \$1,500.00 shall be posted with the Town Finance Office and remain in effect for twelve months following completion of the work.

20. A Certificate of Insurance with P.D.L. and B.I.L. to the minimum limits 500,000/ 500,000 shall be provided to the Town and shall name the Town as an Additional Insured.
